INFO FOR SOARING PILOTS

Welcome to Lone Pine Airport. The following information is provided to make your visit more enjoyable.

GROUND

1. Please do not park vehicles or trailers in the glider tie-down area. Only assembled gliders may be parked in the cable area.
2. Gliders may be assembled in the glider tie-down area and then tied down to the cable.
3. The dirt area along the mound of transient parking has been designated as glider trailer parking. **This is the only designated trailer parking. The area to the south of Runway 13-31 is not to be used.**
4. Vehicles may be parked in the general parking lot.
5. Please keep the taxiway, transient parking/tie-down area clear; the **Air Ambulance** uses this area at all hours.
6. Most glider staging takes place at Runway 13-31; please do not position your glider on the runway until your tow plane is ready to move into position. If you choose to stage at the end of the runway please keep your ground vehicle use to a minimum and keep them off the runway. Be aware of the movement of powered aircraft and their need to take off and land.
7. When staging for take off, please monitor our CTAF (122.8).
8. We have a limited amount of dry camping available. Questions, please contact the Airport Manager.
9. The fee for glider tie-downs is **\$6.00/day, \$25.00/week, or \$45.00/month**. Please pay in the office prior to your departure. Please fill out a registration form at the start of your visit.
10. Any vehicles/trailers on Taxiway A going to and/or from Taxiway B and Runway 16-34, must have a flashing beacon light. Any vehicles/trailers without are not permitted.

AIR

1. Please land on a runway, not the taxiway.
2. Please use your radio to announce your intentions, our frequency is 122.8.
